



# GETTING LISTED ON iTUNES

Publishing Your Community Call™ on the iTunes™ Music Store

TalkShoe allows you to list your recorded Community Call on iTunes and other podcast directories.

Below are instructions on how to submit and list your Community Call™ and previous recordings on the iTunes™ podcast directory and music store (Note: You must have an Apple ID set up to publish your Community Call™ on the iTunes™ Music Store).

1. Go to [www.talkshoe.com](http://www.talkshoe.com)
2. Click on the “Sign In” button.



3. Enter your information and click “Sign In”.
4. Next, click on the “myTalkShoe” button:



5. Once you are at the “myTalkShoe” page, select the call that you would like to list on iTunes, and click on it. This will take you to the Community Call profile page.
6. To publish your Community Call you must have at least one recorded episode, and that episode must be available for downloading or streaming from the profile page. You will know that this has occurred if these two buttons are visible next to an episode of your show:



7. Also, the “RSS Feeds” buttons will become available on the right of the page:



- Under “Share Call” click on “List on iTunes”. A pop-up window will display your feed URL. It should read “feed://recordings.talkshoe.com/rssXX.xml”, where the “XX” at the end represents your Community Call ID. Copy this address (highlight, then CMD or CTRL + C):

- Open iTunes. Click on the “Music Store” option under the “Source” column.
- Once the Music Store has loaded, click on “Podcasts” under the column “Inside the Music store”.
- Once you are at the main podcast page, there should be a large “Submit” button in the middle of the page. Click this button:



- On this page, paste (CMD or CTRL + V) your Community Call's feed address (that we copied in step 8) into the designated box:

- Click “Continue”, and follow the on-screen instructions.
- You should receive a response from Apple within approximately three business days confirming your submission and subsequent listing.
